



Red Wine

- {BIN 211} **J. Lohr, Merlot ~ Los Osos, Paso Robles Vineyard, California** 32 -
Dark crimson with a vibrant hue. Aromas of black cherry and blackberry fruit are framed with a signature, light chestnut oak note to complement the flavors of currant and cranberry. The addition of Malbec and Petit Verdot bring characteristic bright notes to an already flavorful wine. Our J. Lohr Los Osos Merlot is medium-bodied with firm and structured tannins, with a finish that is bright and activates the palate.
- {BIN 212} **Buried Cane, Merlot ~ Washington State** 28 -
Buried Cane Merlot has plenty of sweet cherry and berry flavors, with complex aromas that include earthy mint, tobacco, and spices like nutmeg and clove. Enjoy it with everything from pizza to grilled meats.
- {BIN 213} **Yalumba, Shiraz Viognier (7%) ~ Angaston, Australia** 32 -
A very attractive nose showing warmer aromatics of heady ripe berry fruits. The Viognier lends fragrant notes of apricot blossom and musk. The palate is very approachable, with ripe raspberry and ju-jube-like flavors, quite plush and smooth finishing with a long velvety texture.
- {BIN 214} **Rivers Edge, Pinot Noir , Umpqua Valley, Oregon** 46 -
Grapes from our two estate vineyards as well as two neighboring vineyards were the sources for this wine. It has a complex bouquet of strawberry, delicate flavors of cherry and vanilla, and candied cherry/earthy finish. The wine was aged in a combination of French, Hungarian and American oak cooperage.
- {BIN 215} **Sterling, Pinot Noir ~ Vintners Collection, Central Coast, California** 29 -
Clear deep ruby, with complex, vibrant varietal aromas of briar fruit and ripe black cherries, with hints of vanilla. The fruit jumps out of the glass, with big black cherry flavors from entry to finish. The tannins are soft and there is a resonant touch of earth in the lingering finish.
- {BIN 216} **Ravenswood, Zinfandel~ Vintners Blend ~ Sonoma, California** 24 -
This wine displays aromas of red berries, herbs & spice. The dark fruit character carries through mid-palate, finishing with a lingering spicy finish.



Red Wine

- {BIN 217} **Aquinas, Cabernet Sauvignon ~ Napa Valley, California** 36 -
A dense red color with deep plum edges. The rich cassis, coffee and sweet leather aromas fold into a supple matrix of blueberry, blackberry, and black currant. The finish features integrated tannins with good astringency and subtle vanilla notes. The lingering finish is a symphony of raspberry and caramel.
- {BIN 218} **Zolo, Bonarda, ~ Mendoza, Argentina** 28 -
The Zolo Bonarda with its ultra-aromatic complexity is made for those special occasions when one needs a wine to "knock your hat off." Argentina's most planted varietal, the Argentine Bonarda, like the Malbec, is on fire in the U.S. This wine highlights the grape's characteristically raspberry aromas and strawberry jam. Smooth with soft sweet tannins, finishing with toasty barrel notes.
- {BIN 219} **Conquista, Malbec ~ San Rafael, Argentina** 24 -
This medium weight wine shows classic Malbec character ~ generous red fruit flavors complemented by intriguing accents of herbs & spices.
- {BIN 220} **Borsao, Tres Picos, Garnacha ~ Borja (Zaragoza), Spain** 32 -
It has a dark ruby color with shades of purple. At the nose there is a rich aroma of ripe berries with hints of floral tones typical of the Garnacha, a unique variety. In the mouth, it is a full bodied rich wine with a taste of blackberries, strawberries and hints of leather, vanilla and plums. It is perfectly combined with a sweet and pleasant tannin that leads to a long, balanced and smooth finish..
- {BIN 221} **Altocedro, Año Cero Malbec ~ Mendoza, Argentina** 32 -
91 points ('08), Wine & Spirits; 89 points ('09), Wine Spectator: "Ripe and racy, with nice invigorating acidity driving the delicious raspberry, boysenberry and licorice notes. The long finish lets graphite and incense notes chime in.
- {BIN 222} **Banfi, Chianti Classico Riserva ~ Italy** 35 -
Wonderful aromatics with mixed crushed red and black berries, cherry extract, sweet tobacco, roasted herbs, cranberry compote, saddle leather and earthy minerals. In the mouth, the wine expands on the palate to reveal concentrated cherry fruit, cranberry juice cocktail, ripe brambleberries, currant parfait and smoke-laced herbs.



White Wine

- {BIN 111} **Simi, Sauvignon Blanc** ~ Sonoma County, California 32 -
Bursts of grapefruit, Meyer lemon and orange blossoms are laced with lemon grass and mineral notes. Intense flavors of tangerine, melon and fig accented with green tea and hints of mineral on the finish.
- {BIN 112} **Tohu, Sauvignon Blanc** ~ Marlborough New Zealand 34 -
Bright green with a touch of pale yellow our Unoaked Chardonnay is all about fresh fruit. Aromas of bright tropical pineapples and melons are combined with a touch of creaminess from the malolactic fermentation. Apples, citrus and peaches are found on a full bodied and textured palate with some complex and meaty elements. Intensely flavored the wine finishes with length and dryness.
- {BIN 113} **A to Z, Pinot Gris** ~ Newburg, Oregon 32 -
Shimmers in the glass with pear, ginger, almond and vanilla aromas. Juicy, bright and succulent on the attack, this wine showcases flavors of tangerine, melon, pineapple and wet stone. The wine is framed by ripe acidity giving classic Oregon Pinot Gris proportions and lift to the richness. The long finish slides effortlessly from the mid-palate with lingering impressions of tantalizing, pure, intense fruit.
- {BIN 114} **Zolo, Torrontés** ~ Mendoza, Argentina 28 -
The Wall Street Journal ('07); 89 points, Robert Parker ('08): "Medium straw-colored with a fragrant perfume of honey, spring flowers, and tropical fruits. Ripe, flavorful, dry, and restrained, this is Torrontes at its best.
- {BIN 115} **Vouvray, Robert Michele** ~ Loire Valley Sur Loire, France 30 -
This Loire Valley wine has a pleasing bouquet. It is soft and pleasant – never dry or austere. Perfect with fish, veal and poultry
- {BIN 116} **R.H. Phillips, EXP, Viognier** ~ Dunnigan Hills, California 36 -
Fragrant orange blossom, jasmine and tropical fruit aromas. On the palate the wine is rich, with a creamy texture and intriguing hints of honey and spice. The finish is long, with vibrant flavors of kiwi, lychee and apricot.



White Wine

- {BIN 117} **Chateau St Michelle, Riesling** ~ Columbia Valley, Washington 26 -
Bright and jazzy, with fleshiness to the texture that adds an extra dimension to the lively pear and floral aromas and flavors, picking up a wet stone note on the finish.
- {BIN 118} **Bertani, Due Uve** ~ Veneto, Italy 28 -
The name (pronounced Do-Ay OO-vay) means two grapes, which aptly describes this beguiling and innovative estate-bottled blend of Pinot Grigio and Sauvignon Blanc grapes. Color: Pale straw, with lively green reflections Bouquet: Assertive and well-defined. Nuances of elderflower combined with hints of peach and apricot. Taste: Full bodied and well balanced
- {BIN 119} **Foris, Gewurztraminer** ~ Rogue Valley, Oregon 32 -
The beautifully pink fruit, small, tight clusters, and very spicy flavors let you know that you have great fruit to work with. Citrus and rose blossoms intermingle to create a heady floral perfume. Rich, yet restrained by ample acidity, the flavors are reminiscent of white peach, kiwi, grapefruit zest and a trace of ginger spice.
- {BIN 120} **Banfi, San Angelo, Pinot Grigio** ~ Montalcino, Italy 34 -
"A round, lightly floral wine with a fullness and spice that brings lots of appeal. The fruit flavors are completely ripe, edging into the tropical, and the ripeness makes you want to take another sip." - Wine & Spirits
- {BIN 121} **Sterling, Chardonnay** ~ Napa Valley, California 34 -
Exudes Napa style with full body, rich flavors and a bright freshness. Up front, crisp Asian pear, pippin apple and tropical fruit guide the entry, balanced by notes of caramel, ginger and clove. Across the middle, the Carneros grapes show their face, lifting the silky fruit with a distinct lemon essence and sprightly minerality that carries through the finish..
- {BIN 122} **Rodney Strong, Chalk Hill, Chardonnay** ~ California 38 -
Barrel fermentation in new and seasoned French oak added toasty vanilla and spice complexities, and during 8 months of barrel ageing, we regularly stirred the "lees" in barrel, which gives a certain fullness and creamy texture on the palate. Encouraging malolactic fermentation added additional character, and in the glass the wine is both creamy and crisp, with abundant fruit character, mineral, and toasty oak flavors
